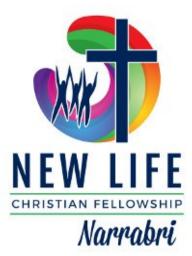

# PASTOR'S REPORT

Although we don't measure our success by events, we have certainly had some memorable times in 2018.



The Family Camp in February was probably our biggest yet. A great time was had as we thought about the power of the Holy Spirit. We discovered that we have some young playwrights and other creatives in our midst. For many of us the highlight was the time we could spend just hanging out together.

In April we had another "Big Family" event with the Big Family Gathering. This event was a follow up to the Come Together weekend in 2017 and involved

members of all Narrabri churches combining to present an event for children and youth. Sean W. Smith was our main speaker and he gave a great evangelistic message. Many people, including some nonchristians thought this was a great event the church should do every year. The organising committee is happy to have a rest and see what God would have us to plan.



Events such as Come Together and the Big Family Gathering give us opportunities to engage with people who don't know Jesus in a relaxed, comfortable setting. The community sees the church giving something back, but we have a chance to talk about faith in individual conversations as well as in music and spoken messages.

Messy Church has been a big feature of our church this year. We approach our worship as little children and explore different ways of exploring the scriptures. Messy Church provides us with an experience of a particular theme in art, craft, science, cooking, prayer and reflection. Having lunch together then helps to build our sense of belonging. Messy Church is meant to be a missional movement which makes the idea of church more accessible to people who are not church members. In 2019, I would love to get a venue where we can do "Messy" on a regular basis, perhaps on a Sunday afternoon.



After several years of pondering possibilities, Margaret took a big step and started Play Group on Wednesday mornings. At the moment we are establishing a core group, but we are hoping that over time this will grow and draw in parents from across the community. Setting up, running and putting away the Play Group equipment is tiring but rewarding.

Finally, cell groups continue their important work of building community, equipping disciples and reaching out. It is slow, but vital work in encouraging and exhorting everyone to reach the full measure of Christ. I look forward to the groups growing in both quality and number over the next year.
